Only from our own vineyards, each parcels were hand harvested, carried in small boxes of 12 kgs to the winery and kept separate throughout the whole fermentation process which occurred with controlled temperatures in small open fermenters and were the grapes were crushed by foot folliwing the tradicional methotd. Malhadinha aged for 14 months in new French oak barrels.

Winemaker's Notes

Malhadinha presents a deep intense colour, fresh fruit flavour and elegant with a floral touch.

On the mouth it is dense showing a good tanic structure and strong caracter.
