Winemaking

The grapes were grown in our vineyards and hand harvested, carried in small boxes of 12kg early in the morning to the winery and sorted destemming and lightly crushed.

Grapes were selected, and gently pressed. Fermentation occured in controlled temperature in stainless steel. Later on the wine rested in new french oak barrels (225Lts) for 14 months.

Winemaker's Notes

Malhadinha red 2007 shows a black and shiny color. Aroma is characterized by fine spices, red fruits and balsamic notes. In the mouth it is creamy, well-structured and powerful.
