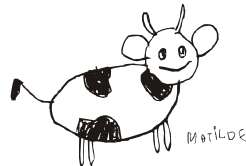
**Vinification**  
Grapes were hand picked into 12 Kg boxes and selected at the sorting table. Fermentation occurred in stainless steel lagares with temperature control and traditional maceration. Aged for 17 months in new French oak barrels.

**Tasting Notes**  
Since 2004, debut year of Malhadinha, we have put our craft and art at the service of this wine. The truth is that every year we find in it a different personality, every year it shows its temper. It's with a deep respect for the vineyard that we manage to extract the best each year provides, and put it at the disposal of our most distinguished wine. 2010 showed this to be a massive Malhadinha, dressed with structure and concentration. However, this is also a Malhadinha of delicious ripe fruit and intense flavour. A Malhadinha from Alentejo.
