Winemaking
Only from our own vineyards, each parcels were hand harvested, carried in small boxes of 12 kgs to the winery and kept separate throughout the whole fermentation process which occurred with controlled temperatures in small open fermenters and were the grapes were crushed by foot following the traditional method. Malhadinha aged for 26 months in new French oak barrels.

Winemaker's Notes
Aroma is deep and complex like dark fruits, toasted almonds and spices. It has a rich fruit flavour with great elegance. Its tannin structure is robust and allows the wine to reach a long life without losing its taste, by the contrary.
