Vinification
Grapes were hand picked into 12 Kg boxes and selected at the sorting table. Fermentation occurred in stainless steel lagares with temperature control and traditional maceration. Aged for 26 months in new French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes
Dark and opaque color, Marias 2010 shows great complexity on the nose. Notes of dark and red ripe fruits, spices and toast. Very elegant on the palate although the wine has a great structure and body.
Firm but silky tannins. Very long finish.
