Vinification

Manually harvested grapes into 12kg boxes and rigorously selected at the choosing table. Fermentation happened in temperature controlled press with various treads throughout the process. 16 months staging in new french oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

The 2019 edition of Marias da Malhadinha Red is based on the Old Vineyards of Vale Travessos, planted in 1949. With a concentrated ruby color, complex nose with hints of red and wild berries, a vegetable and spicy touch from large quality barrels. A full and dense flavour, with a tannin presence but fine, elegant and prolonged finish, a Marias for the table and for the cellar.
