Grapes were hand picked into 12 Kg boxes and selected at the sorting table. Fermentation occurred in stainless steel lagares with temperature control and traditional maceration. Aged for 18 months in new French oak barrels.

Taste

Menino António 2012 shows great aromatic complexity with notes of red and black fruits, spices, graphite and liquorice, the oak is present but integrated. A balsamic hint gives freshness to the bouquet. On the palate the attack is supple but starts to grow due its tannical structure, good acidity and long finish. Needs time to reveal all it has to offer.
