## Winemaking

The grapes were grown in our vineyards and hand harvest, carried in small boxes of 12Kg eraly in the morning to the winery and sorted destemming and lightly crushed. Grapes were selected, and gently pressed. Fermentation occured in controlled temperature in stainless steel.

## Winemaker notes

Arinto da Peceguina 2009 shows itself a clean and slightly greensih color. In the noe you can identify citrus and mineral aromas and in the mouth the palate is very fresh and alive, revealing impressive and a long finish.
