Winemaking

The grapes were grown in our vineyard and picked by hand, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery and sorted before destemming and lightly crushing. Open-fermentation process occurred with controlled temperatures in small open fermenters. The wine aged in New French Barrels (225 Lts) for 10 months.

Winemaker's notes

Aragonês da Peceguina 2008 is a dense wine with hints of violet and a flavor that highlights the red fruit and minerality involved in a toast and chocolate notes.

Its appearance has a bright color and very concentrated with a silky texture and complex flavor. The palate is intense and concentrated wine with strong tannins. The finish is long and persistent.
