Winemaking
The grapes were grown in our vineyards and picked by hand, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery and sorted before destemming and lightly crushing. Fermentation occurred at low temperatures and lasted about 1 month.

Winemaker Notes
Antão Vaz aroma makes his mark since it represents 60% of the lot. Smoked and buttery notes associated to citric flavour. Powerful, a very expressive white, Arinto gives him the freshness on the mouth and a good acidity. Roupeiro full fill him of tipicity, which makes a great combination to eat with fat fish.
