The grapes were grown in our vineyards and hand harvested, carried in small boxes of 12kg early in the morning to the winery and sorted destemming and lightly crushed.
Grapes were selected, and gently pressed.
Fermentation occurred in controlled temperature in stainless steel

Mineral and fruit flavour. Very soft and smooth with lively and delicatated acidity. You can easily taste «Roupeiro» grape variety. It's an excellent choice to escort with fat fish dishes.
