Winemaking
The grapes were grown in our vineyards and hand harvested, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery and sorted before destemming and lightly crushing.
Fermentation occurred at low temperatures and it lasted for 28 days.

Winemaker's Notes
Rosé da Peceguina is a fresh, fruity wine with a bright pink colour. The vibrant aromas feature a rich bouquet of red berry fruit. On the mouth, the deliciously sweet, creamy texture is well balanced by crisp acidity, ripe fruit and a friendly finish.
