Winemaking

The grapes were grown in our vineyards and hand harvest, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery and sorted before destemming and lightly crushing. Rosé da Peceguina is a result of sangrias of our best red moist after 2 or 3 days of cold maceration. Fermentation occurred at low temperatures and it lasted for 21 days.

Winemaker Notes

This Rosé is a wine with a distinct character that can't be denied, since it is an excellent wine. It is a fresh, fruited wine with a bright pink colour. The vibrant aromas feature a rich bouquet of red fruits like cherry and strawberry mixed with tropical acid fruits like passion fruit. On the mouth, the deliciously sweet, creamy texture is well balanced by crisp acidity, with a friendly finish.
