Winemaking

The grapes were grown in our vineyards and hand harvest, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery and sorted before destemming and lightly crushing. Rosé da Peceguina is a result of sangrias of our best red moist after 2 or 3 days of cold maceration. Fermentation occurred at low temperatures and it lasted for 21 days.

Winemaker Notes

Peceguina Rosé has an elegant aroma combined with a powerfull color. On the nose you can easily identify fresh fruit and candy while in the mouth the fruit gives a smooth and balanced end with excellent acidity.
