### Winemaking

The grapes were grown in our vineyards and hand harvest, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery and sorted before destemming and lightly crushing. Rosé da Peceguina is a result of sangrias of our best red moist after 2 or 3 days of cold maceration. Fermentation occurred at low temperatures and it lasted for 21 days.

### Winemaker Notes

This Rosé is a wine with a distinct character that can't be denied. It presents himself fruited with a bright pink colour. On the nose you can easily identify red fruit combined with floral notes. On the mouth, it has an excellent volume, with well balanced acidity.
