Winemaking

The grapes were grown in our vineyards and hand harvest, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery and sorted before destemming and lightly crushing. Rosé da Peceguina is a result of sangrias of our best red moist after 2 or 3 days of cold maceration. Fermentation occurred at low temperatures and it lasted for 21 days.

Winemaker Notes

Very clean aroma with good fruit, with great evidence of red fruit aromas. Demonstrates great expression and smoothness in the mouth. Young and round with fruit in the beginning. Simple and easy to drink in the day-to-day.
