**Winemaking**  
Grapes grown in our estate were hand harvest in 12Kg small boxes and sorted before being destemmed and slightly crushed. Monte da Peceguina Rosé is the result of selected bleedings on our top red musts. The bleed is made after 2 or 3 days of cold soak. The wine fermented in stainless steel vats at low temperatures for 3 weeks.

**Winemaker's Notes**  
Rosé with a vibrant pink color. Intense on the nose, very fruity with floral notes. Good presence on the palate, structured but fresh with red berries fruits standing out. The soft tannins and a balanced acidity make this Rosé an excellent wine to go with food.
