Winemaking
Grapes grown in our estate were hand harvested in 12Kg small boxes and sorted before being destemmed and slightly crushed. Monte da Peceguina Rosé is the result of selected bleedings on our top red musts. The bleed is made after 1 or 2 days of cold soak. The wine fermented in stainless steel vats at low temperatures for 3 weeks.

Winemaker's Notes
Soft salmon colored. Clean and fresh aroma dominated by notes of red fruits and slightly spiced. Light and refreshing on the mouth.
