Vinification

Grapes grown in our estate were hand harvested in 12Kg small boxes and sorted before being destermed and slightly crushed. Monte da Peceguina Rosé is the result of direct pressings and selected bleedings on our top red musts. The bleed is made after a couple of hours of cold soak. The wine fermented is stainless steel vats at low temperatures for 3 weeks.

Tasting Notes

Soft salmon colored. The Monte da Peceguina Rosé 2014 shows a fresh aroma dominated by notes of red fruits and floral hints. On the palate is fresh and dry with lively acidity.
