## Vinification

Manually harvested grapes into 12kg boxes and rigorously selected in the choosing table. Fermentation occurred in a wine press and in cylindrical-conical vats, at a controlled temperature during the many presses throughout the whole process. Partial staging of 12 months in French oak barrels.

## Notas de Prova

The most recent edition of Monte da Peceguina red reveals a nose with good aromatic intensity where red and wild fruits stand out, together with floral notes, and well-integrated barrel notes. On the mouth the fruit is generous like the structure of the wine. The finely tuned tannins and a good acidity result in a balanced Monte da Peceguina Red 2019 and with good persistency.
