Winemaking

The grapes grew in our vineyard and picked by hand, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery. Fermentation process occurred under controlled temperature in small tanks where grapes were crushed by traditional method. The wine aged in French oak barrels for 7 months.

Winemaker notes

Monte da Peceguina red 2008 harvest is concentrated in color with violet reflections. The nose is characterized by red fruit notes without losing freshness. Austerity in the mouth. with an good tannines structure. In the mouth is really fresh and then finalized with a good tannins structure.
A wine with good potencial and evolution in the bottle.
