Winemaking

The grapes grew in our vineyard and picked by hand, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery. Fermentation process occurred under controlled temperature in small tanks where grapes were crushed by traditional method. The wine aged in French oak barrels for 7 months.

Winemakers notes

Monte da Peceguina red, 2009 harvest presents itself concentrated in the color with violet reflexes. In the nose you can easily identify a clean fruit aroma concentrated with firm tannins. On the mouth, a good volume and a well balanced acidity are the main characteristics.
