The grapes were grown in our vineyard and picked by hand, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery and sorted before destemming and lightly crushing. Fermentation occurred at low temperatures and lasted for 28 days The wine aged in new American and Frech barrels (225 Lts) for 6 months.

Winemaker's notes

Pequeno João 2007 Harvest, shows an intense black and shiny color. Easily noticeable aroma of black fruit, very mineral. A freshness in the mouth offers a perfect combination of crunchy black fruit and notes of chocolate and spices. The Taste of wood is completely integrated into the wine.
